Treasurers report 2020-2021

Despite a difficult year with COVID, meaning that operations had to be put on hold for several weeks during lockdown, RoxFM have managed to secure a profit for the second year in a row. Operating expenses have continued to stay low despite the additional costs of employing a station manager and the purchase of several small pieces of equipment, including a laptop and remote recording devices.

Grants:

The Community Broadcasting Foundation (CBF) gave the station two COVID grants during the course of the year amounting to \$7,900 which has covered a significant amount of our operating expenses for the year.

Sponsors:

RoxFM would like to thank our major sponsors Raine & Horne, AutoPro and Roxby Downs Community Club for their ongoing support over many years. We would also like to thank the following sponsors who have supported us during 2020-21: BHP, Subway, Red Appointments, Roxby District Sporting Club, Dine-A-Mite Café, Aerodrome Management Services, and Wayans Remidial Chinese Massage.

ATO Debt:

We have continued to pay off our ATO debt for PAYG from 2019 and earlier at a rate of \$1,026.08 a month. We have been charged interest of \$1,606.35 over the course of the year. Our current debt to the ATO stands at \$19,198.87. We hope to pay this off during the course of the 2021-2022 financial year.

Station Manager:

In February 2021 we employed Deb Price as our new station manager on a part time casual basis. Deb has a long history with the station having been a volunteer for 7 years and we are pleased to have her on board. Whilst an employee is financially difficult the board believe that the benefits of a station manager far outweigh the risks. All PAYG and superannuation payments for Deb are up to date and do not form part of the ATO debt.

Evening of Acoustic Entertainment:

In March 2021 RoxFM held an Acoustic Event at the Roxby Downs Race Course. This was made possible through funding of \$4,000 from the BHP Community Donations program. Sponsorship was also received from the following: Roxby Downs Racing Club, The Oasis, Roxby Tavern, Roxby Downs Community Club, Hornridge Sporting Club, Secker Real Estate, Stephens Resources, Woolworths, Leicester Management Services, Roxby Signs, Roxby Traders, Roxby Downs Scouts and Ruby Run Livestock Baroota. Along with ticket sales RoxFM made a profit from the sale of merchandise.

The evening provided music to an audience of approximately 75 people. The evening promoted positive mental health through access to live music in a peaceful environment. Entertainment was provided by 4 acts from Roxby Downs, Andamooka, Port Augusta and Adelaide supporting the music industry who have been severely affected during COVID. The event was well received by everyone with people noting how great it was to have access to live music, what an enjoyable evening it was and the police noting what a chilled out atmosphere there was —they wished they could have stayed longer.

Merchandise:

\$1,335 was spent on the purchase of caps, stubble holders, stickers and magnets. Merchandise was sold at the concert event and has also been sold at Market Days.

Website:

During 2020 RoxFM volunteers, Milly & Jamie Breward, created a new website for the station. The CBAA removed hosting for the previous website which left us with a decision of paying huge amounts of money to continue with the original website, paying huge amounts of money for CBAA to move the site to Wordpress or rebuild the site ourselves. The website was rebuilt by Milly and hosting and relocation was secured by Jamie to a new Wordpress site. Much of the photo content has been sourced from Facebook, giving a great feel of continuity and community from the past and present. There will be some small ongoing costs of the new website.
